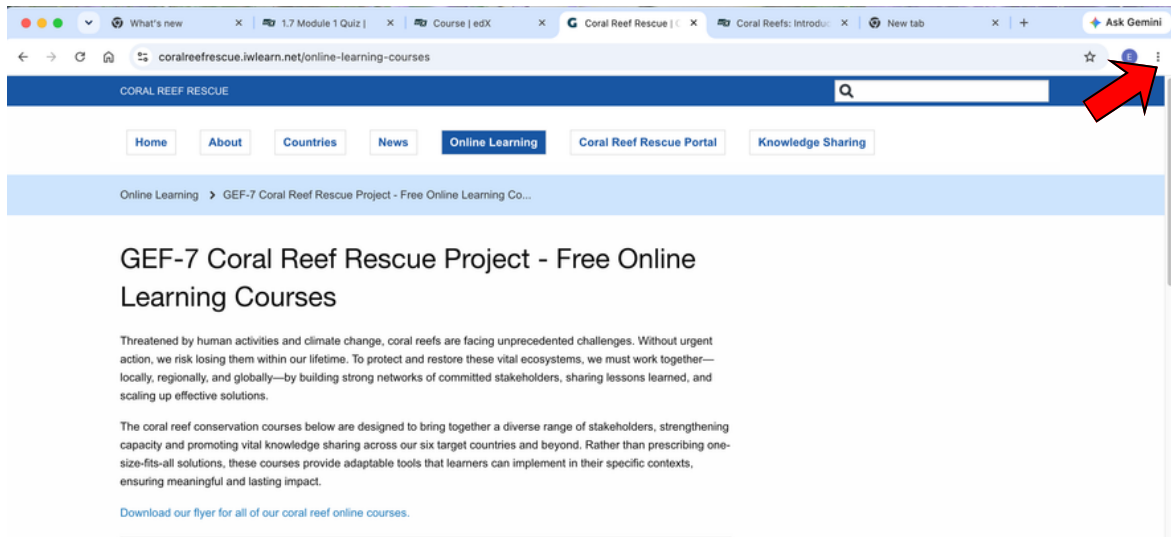
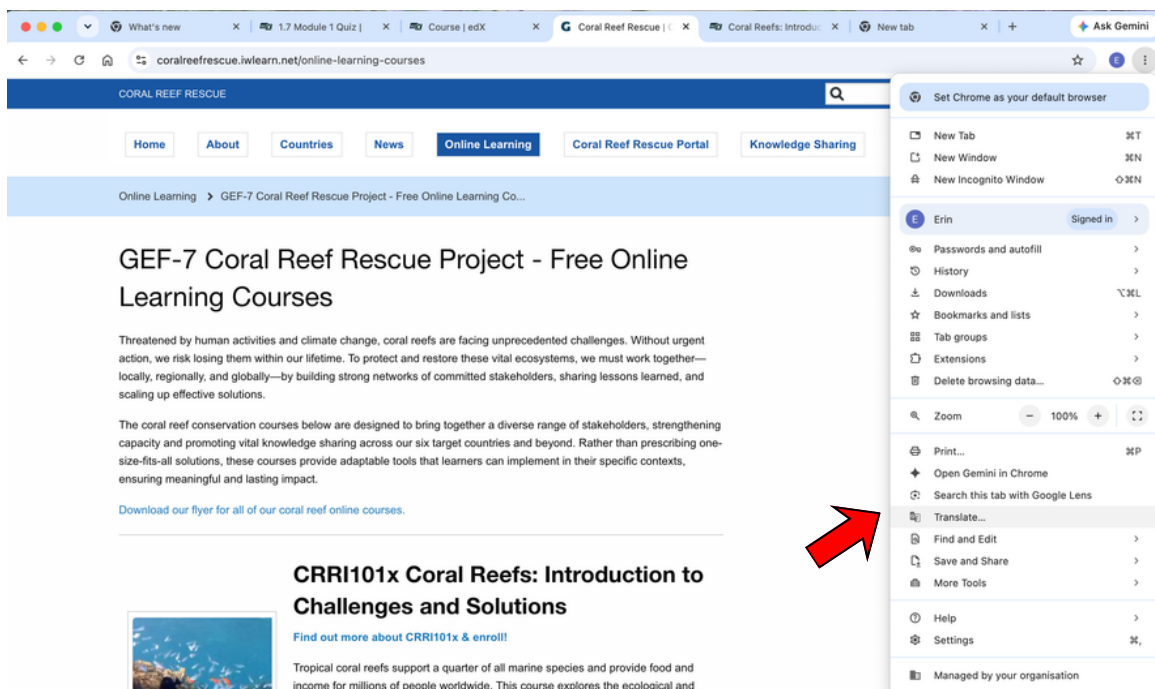

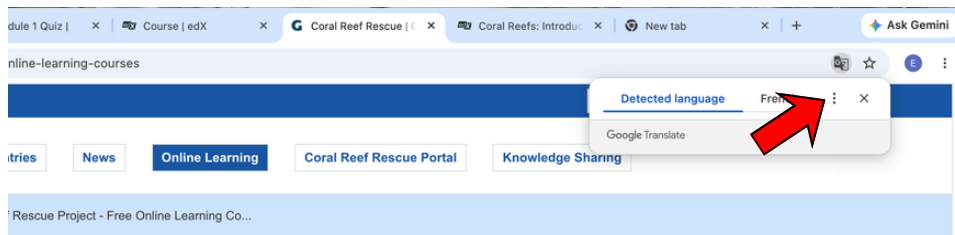
1. Buka situs web IW Learn—Coral Reef Rescue menggunakan browser Google Chrome.
2. Klik ikon tiga titik di sudut kanan atas jendela browser untuk membuka menu.



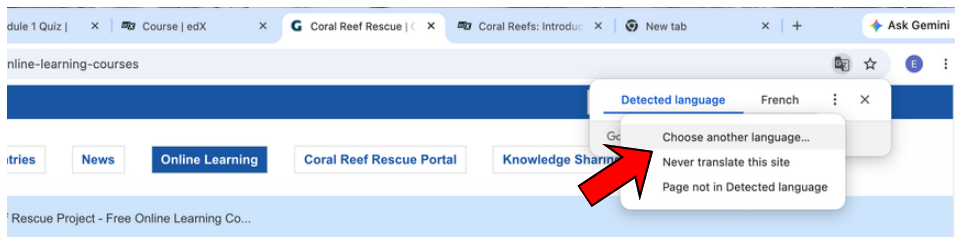
3. Pilih opsi Terjemahkan.



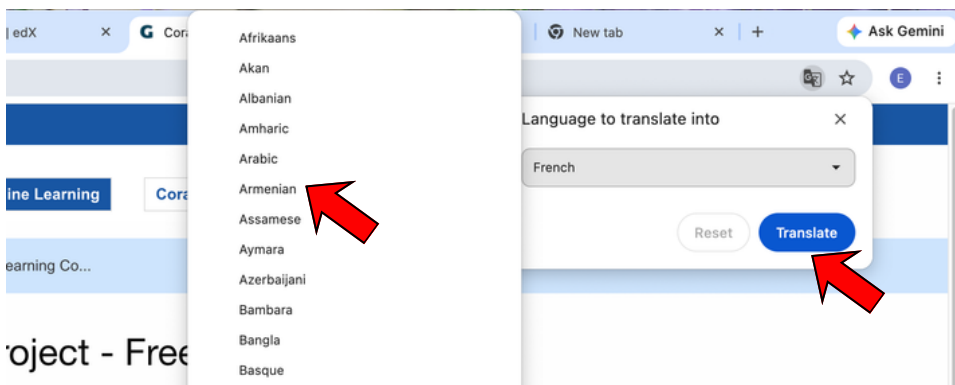
